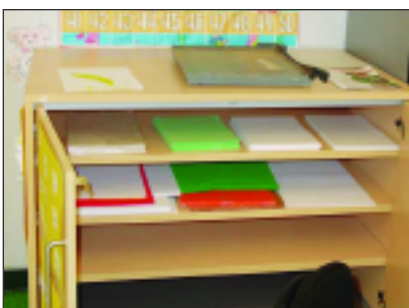
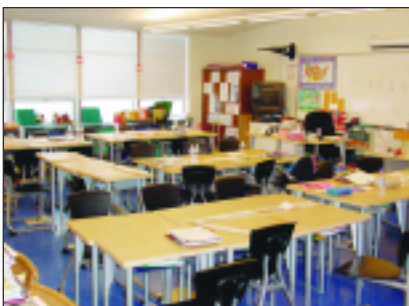


HERCULES ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

The Problem:

Hercules Elementary School was looking for a holistic provider of innovative educational products for one of their newly constructed schools. The school was located in the West Contra Costa unified school district near the San Francisco Bay Area. The district overall, was looking for products that could perform at every educational level. The focus was for diversified products to serve their 34,000 students from kindergarten through grade 12 as well as adult education. The district worked with WLC architects in Emeryville California, to design the project for Hercules Elementary School. In turn the One Workplace dealership in Milpitas suggested the LearningWorks team to see what they could come up with to accommodate the customer's requests.

The Solution:

One Workplace began communicating the needs of the school district and specifically Hercules Elementary.
